RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT

hereof and for one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration paid by Cash Special Utility District (hereinafter called "Grantee"), the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, transfer, and convey to said Grantee, its successors and assigns, a non-exclusive perpetual easement with the right to erect, construct, install, and lay and thereafter use, operate, inspect, repair, maintain, replace, and remove a water line(s) over and across those portions of Grantors' property, ______ acres of land, more particularly described in an instrument recorded in Volume , Page____, or Document of the Official Records of County, Texas, which are either already within an area or easement in which there exists a waterline previously constructed by Grantee or contiguous at all points to a public road or right-of-way and/or necessary to the construction of the line herein contemplated, together with the right of ingress and egress over Grantors' adjacent lands for the purpose for which the above mentioned rights are granted; provided that Grantee shall minimize use of Grantors' adjacent lands and shall not interfere with. The easement hereby granted shall not exceed twenty feet (20') in width, and Grantee is hereby authorized to designate the course of the easement herein conveyed except that when the pipe line(s) is installed, the easement herein granted shall be limited to a strip of land twenty feet (20') in width the center line thereof being the original pipe line as installed.

The consideration recited herein shall constitute payment in full for all damages sustained by Grantors by reason of the installation of the structures referred to herein and the Grantee will maintain such easement in a state of good repair and efficiency so that no unreasonable damages will result from its use to Grantors' premises. This Agreement together with other provisions of this grant shall constitute a covenant running with the land for the benefit of the Grantee, its successors, and assigns.
